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Hotel Patriarca 3★ in San Vito al Tagliamento

The family-run Hotel Patriarca 3★ is centrally located in San Vito al Tagliamento, near Torre Raimonda, the city walls, and Palazzo Rota.

It offers 29 rooms (including two accessible rooms) with air conditioning, satellite TV, Wi-Fi, minibar, safe, and hairdryer. The first floor is accessible by elevator, while the second floor is accessible via stairs. A free luggage service is available upon request for the rooms on the second floor.

The hotel features a bar and restaurant for guests. A small wellness area is available for an extra charge, bookable on-site.

Day 1 | Welcome to Pordenone

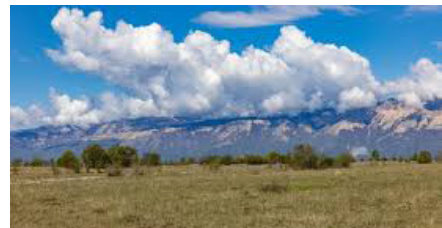
Arrival at the hotel and check-in. Dinner. After dinner, you can enjoy a stroll to get your first impressions of the city and absorb the atmosphere.

Day 2 | Culture, craftsmanship, and the Steppes of Friuli: Pordenone, Spilimbergo, and the Magredi

The day begins with a visit to **Pordenone**, a city that fascinates with its historical center, offering a perfect blend of Renaissance elegance and modernity. As you stroll through the squares and arcades, you'll discover unique sights like the impressive **Loggia del Comune** and the majestic **Palazzo dei Trecento**.

After a **culinary break at an agriturismo in the Magredi area**, you will immerse yourself in the captivating landscape of this unique region: the vast, arid plains of the "Terre Magre," characterized by gravelly soils, sparse vegetation, and the feeling of endless horizons – a stunning natural space that evokes the steppes of Central Europe.

From here, we continue to **Spilimbergo**, known for its **Mosaic School**, a lively workshop where the ancient art is constantly reimagined. The visit ends with a dive into the world of mosaics, as you watch craftsmen at work and admire exceptional artworks.



Day 3 | Castles, villas, and Friulian wines: Valvasone, Villa Manin, and San Vito al Tagliamento

The full-day excursion begins with a guided tour of the imposing **Valvasone Castle**, a medieval fortress perched high on a hill, offering a fascinating glimpse into the history and architecture of the region.

After the castle visit, we head to the **Pitars Winery**, where a **wine tasting of four exquisite wines** takes place, accompanied by **delicious regional specialties** that perfectly complement the flavors of the wines.

The Cantina Pitars is located in the **Grave del Friuli region, one of the most famous wine-growing areas in Friuli**, stretching between the hills and plains around the Tagliamento River and the Carnic Alps.

Next, we visit the magnificent **Villa Manin**, a Venetian masterpiece that was once the residence of the Manin family and today stands as a cultural heritage of the region.

The final stop of the day takes us to **San Vito al Tagliamento**, where we can enjoy a **cappuccino break** and take in the charming atmosphere of this historic town before the excursion ends, leaving us with many unforgettable impressions.

■ Day 4 | Medieval villages, mills and regional products: Sesto al Reghena and Portogruaro

The day begins with a guided tour of **Sesto al Reghena**, a charming medieval village known for its peaceful atmosphere. The village is also listed among the Borghi più belli d'Italia (the most beautiful villages in Italy). A particular highlight is the **Abbey of Sesto al Reghena**, a masterpiece of Romanesque architecture. Afterwards, you will visit a **botanical laboratory**, where you will learn all about the use of herbs and flowers. Here you will have the opportunity to **taste herbal teas and fruit and flower syrups**, accompanied by **special biscuits**, including some flavoured with lavender. The tour then continues to **Portogruaro**, where you will discover the town's historic centre and the picturesque **mills of Sant'Andrea**. Another highlight of the excursion is a **visit to a dairy**, where mozzarella production will be demonstrated. To round off the day, you will enjoy a tasting of Montasio cheese and four other regional cheeses, perfectly reflecting the variety of Friulian tradition.



■ Day 5 | From palaces to Prosecco: Sacile with Palazzo Ragazzoni and the Prosecco Route

The excursion begins with a discovery tour of **Sacile**, a picturesque town known for its elegant historic centre. A special highlight is **Palazzo Ragazzoni**, a magnificent palace decorated with beautiful frescoes. You will then continue along the famous **Prosecco Route**, which leads to **Valdobbiadene in Veneto**, one of the most important production areas of this celebrated wine. Along the way, you will have the opportunity to **visit a winery**, where you will learn more about Prosecco production and **taste different varieties of this refreshing wine together with a light snack**. The day ends with a further visit to **Palazzo Ragazzoni**, offering deeper insight into Venetian architecture and the life of the region's aristocratic families.
