Day 1 | Benvenuti in Liguria

Arrival in **Loano**.
Check in and welcome drink. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 2 | Imperia and Dolceacqua with local products tasting

Breakfast at the hotel. Meeting with the guide and departure for **Imperia**. Walk through **Porto Maurizio** with its historic centre, narrow alleys and views over the Ligurian Sea. Continuation to **Dolceacqua**, one of the most characteristic villages of the Ligurian hinterland, dominated by the Doria Castle. Stroll through the medieval old town. **Wine tasting with local products** in the Dolceacqua area, focusing on Rossese and typical regional specialities. Return to Loano. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3 | Genova with Focaccia tasting

Breakfast at the hotel and then departure for **Genova**. Guided walk through the historic centre, one of the largest medieval centres in Europe, including the area of the Old Harbour and the Strade Nuove, UNESCO World Heritage Site. **Focaccia tasting in a traditional Sciamadda**, discovering one of the most iconic products of Ligurian gastronomy. 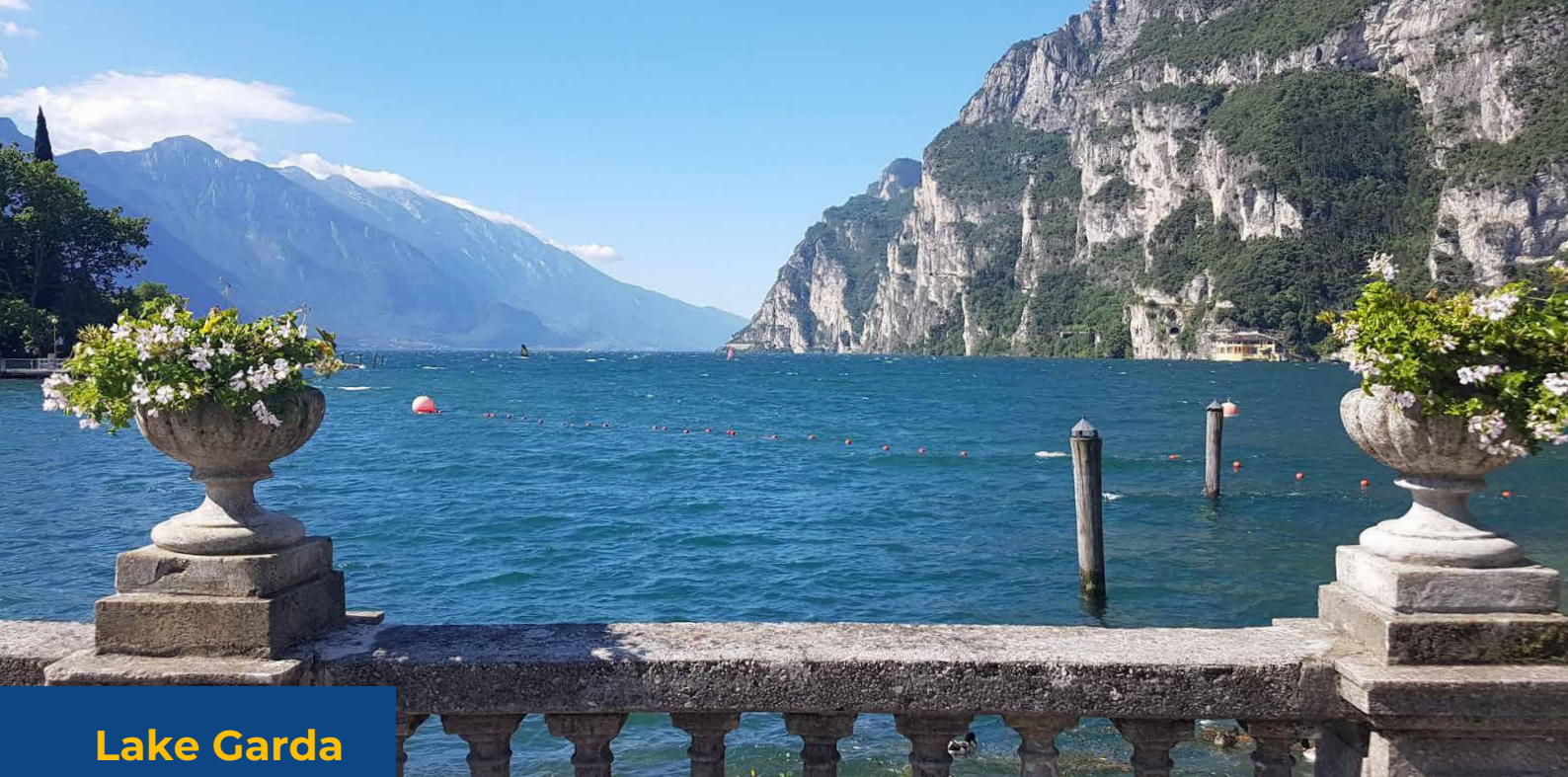

Day 1 | Arrival on the Lake Garda

Day 4 | Salò with visit to olive oil mill

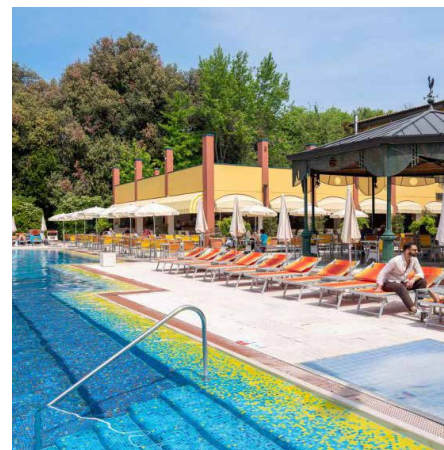
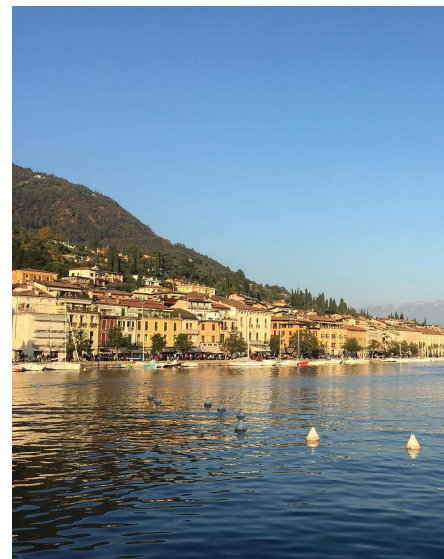

After a walk through the historic center, including the Clock Tower and the Cathedral of Santa Maria Annunziata, guests will have free time for lunch. In the afternoon, they will **visit an olive oil mill** in the western part of Lake Garda, where we'll enjoy a small olive oil tasting. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1 | Welcome to Maremma

Arrival at the hotel, check in and dinner.

Day 2 | Pienza and Montepulciano with cheese tasting

After breakfast departure for the excursion to **Pienza**, named after Pope Pius II who was born here, was transformed in the 15th century from the small village of Corsignano into an ideal Renaissance town. During the visit you will enjoy a **cheese tasting** at Pianporcino in Pienza.

Continuation to **Montepulciano**, famous for the **Vino Nobile di Montepulciano**. Situated on a Tuscan hilltop, the town is renowned for its wine production and refined Renaissance atmosphere. The day cannot end without a **tasting of the regional wines**. Return to the hotel for dinner.

Day 3 | Grosseto and lunch with the Butteri

After breakfast departure for **Grosseto**. The historic centre is surrounded by impressive Medici walls forming a hexagonal fortress with projecting bastions and two gates. On the main square stands a monument to Leopold II, commemorating the reclamation of the Maremma marshlands. Continuation to meet the **Butteri, the traditional cowboys of the Maremma**. With one of the few remaining free herds of purebred Maremma cattle and horses, they demonstrate their daily work: driving and separating the animals, catching and simulated branding, as well as equestrian performances such as the Carosello and other riding displays. Return to the hotel for dinner.

Day 4 | Siena with biscuit tasting

After breakfast departure for **Siena**. Nestled among the rolling Tuscan hills, Siena is one of the finest medieval cities in Italy. During a guided walking tour you will discover **Piazza del Campo, the Palazzo Pubblico and the magnificent Cathedral** with its black and white marble façade, a masterpiece of Italian Gothic architecture. At the end of the visit, **tasting of typical Siennese pastries at the historic Pasticceria Nannini**, including Ricciarelli and Panforte. Return to the hotel for dinner.



Day 5 | Pitigliano and Sovana with olive oil tasting

After breakfast departure towards **Pitigliano** that rises dramatically on a tuff cliff carved by three valleys. Already in Etruscan times, caves were excavated in the rock and used as dwellings and cellars. The village is dominated by **Palazzo Orsini**, the aqueduct and several churches, with picturesque alleys and traces of the ancient synagogue.

Continuation to **Sovana**, birthplace of Pope Gregory VII, a small yet impressive town with important churches and palaces. Nearby are several Etruscan tombs carved into the tuff rock, including the monumental Tomba Ildebranda.

Olive oil tasting at Cencini in Pitigliano.

Return to the hotel for dinner.



Day 6 | Scansano with olive oil tasting and gala dinner

After breakfast departure for **Scansano**, charmingly located on a hill in the heart of the Maremma, famous for **Morellino di Scansano wine** and high quality olive oil.

Guided walk through the historic centre with narrow streets, stone houses and panoramic views over the Tuscan countryside.

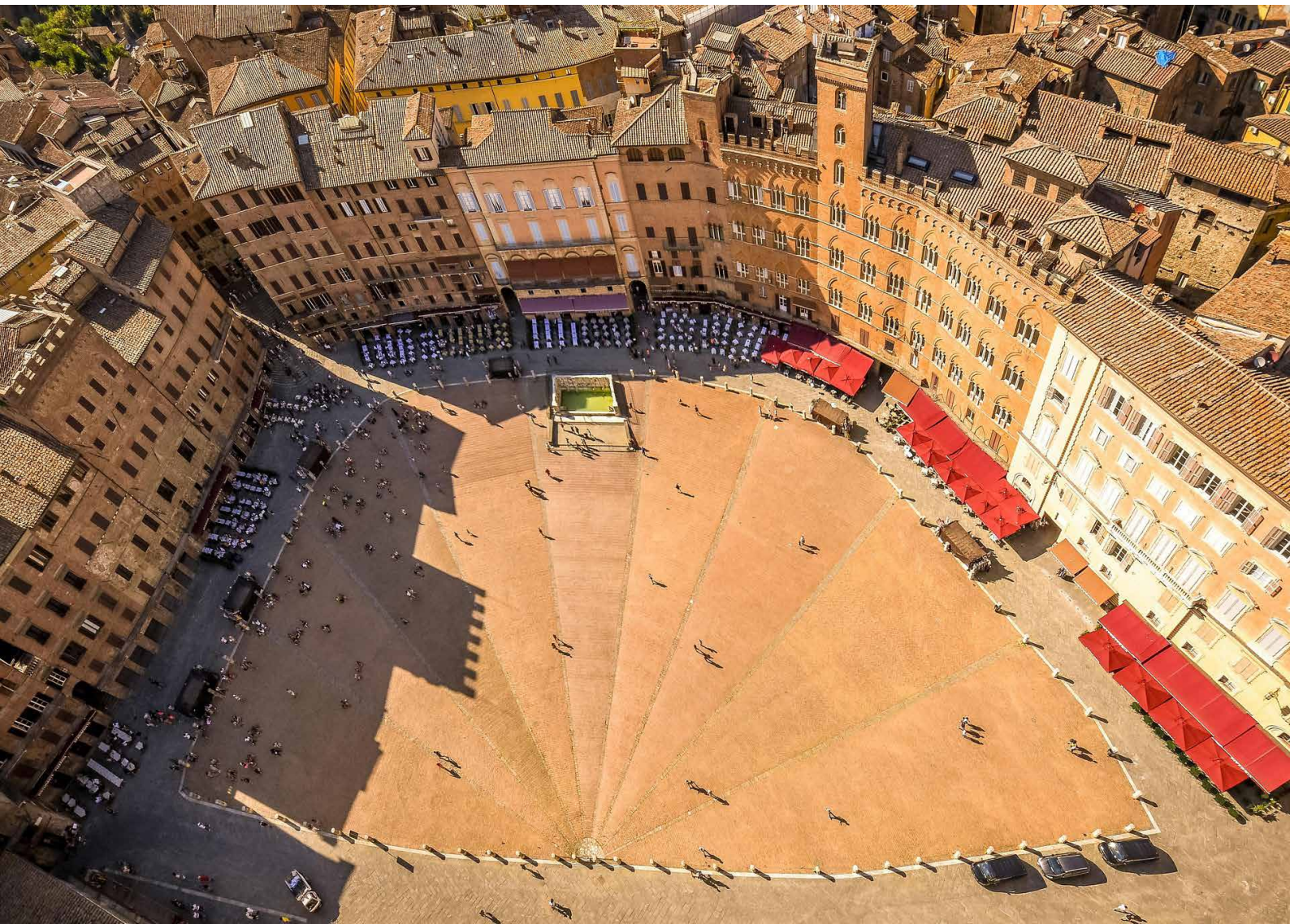

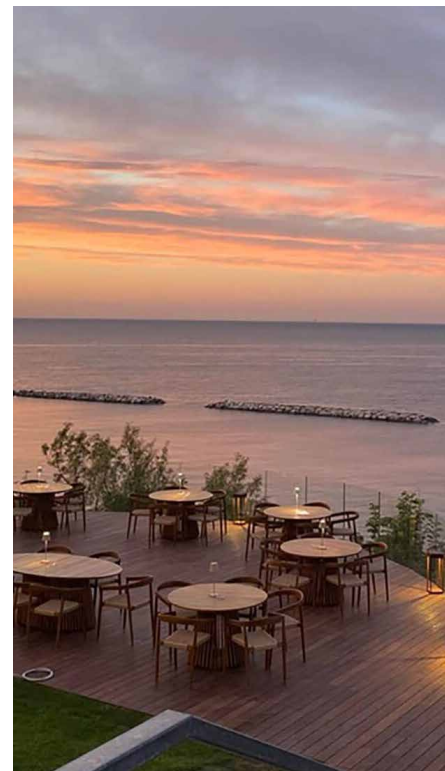

In the afternoon continuation to **San Leo** with optional visit of the impressive fortress perched on a high rock offering wide panoramic views. Visit of the medieval historic centre.
